RESPIRATORY CARE INFORMATION

Program Length -The Respiratory Care program is a 21 month A.S. degree, selective admission program.

Application Deadline-The deadline to apply is the first Friday in May. Applicants will be notified of their selection approximately the third week in May and there will be a mandatory orientation mid-June.

Program Details-The Respiratory Care program is a full-time program. Students will be on campus three days per week in the first semester and will begin clinical rotations (two 8-hour shifts) in the second and third semesters in addition to a minimum of two on-campus days. In the second year, clinic rotations will be two 12-hour shifts and a minimum of two days on campus.

Clinical Rotation Requirements- Clinical sites are Holmes Regional Medical Center, Cleveland Clinic Indian River, Lawnwood Medical Center, St. Lucie Medical Center, Cleveland Clinic Martin North, Cleveland Clinic Tradition and HCA Raulerson. Students will rotate to multiple sites over the course of the program and will be assigned by the instructors each semester.
